Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The institution follows the syllabus prescribed by the affiliated University and according to that all the programmes will be taught by the respective departments. Before the new academic session begins, it is the responsibility of the heads of the departments to allot a detailed timetable which efficiently deploys the units of time for academic and co-curricular purposes. These include, number of working days, list of holidays, examination/assessment schedule, annual events and other celebrations, department activities etc. Only after these dates are identified, it will be easy for the teachers to start working on plans related to their respective classroom teaching & learning. According to a set of teaching plans based on an academic calendar, that is detailed enough to cover the available timeframe, yet flexible enough to permit changes. The teaching plans consist of detailed apportionment of the syllabus among all the faculties of a particular department. The apportioning is done democratically through discussion and deliberations among faculties in departmental meetings. Faculty members take utmost care to complete the syllabus on time. Practical/Assignments, class tests and internal assessments comprise the formal evaluative processes, but students are encouraged to meet faculty beyond classroom hours for doubt-clearing and curricular discussions. Extra hours are devoted to taking remedial classes after completion of internal examinations to bolster students' preparedness before Semester examinations. The College makes continuous and conscious efforts to enable the students to realize their potential in the society. Some of the methods employed by the college in this process are experiential learning through which the Students intern with hospitals and provide hands-on training and make them professionally fit. Field trips to Grape farms, Coir and fibre industry, Indian Cardamom Research Institute, Mayiladumpara etc. are organized to promote grass root understanding of concepts. The students participate in various academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities within and outside the college. The college is well equipped ICT facilities which is extensively used by teachers in day to day teaching to make delivery of the curriculum attractive to students. Interactive teaching is promoted through students' participation in group discussions, quizzes and seminars. Special lectures delivered by eminent scholars on topics related to the curriculum further intensify students' learning experience. The competitive spirit of the students is improved through internal tests, quiz and class tests. Periodic meetings of IQAC take stock of the progress of teaching learning, meetings of the Department with Principal and other stake holders of the institution are regularly monitored and necessary course of actions are initiated. All these methods help the teachers feel satisfied in their job of completing the syllabus within the stipulated time.</p>
